

# The Board of Health Self-Evaluation 2015

**Introduction:** The Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit's Board of Health was given an opportunity to participate in a board of health self-evaluation. The evaluation focused on the boards' role and responsibilities, meetings and the board chair. An electronic survey was distributed directly to all board members via email. They were advised that their responses would be kept confidential and that a summary report would be prepared. A total of nine surveys were fully completed and submitted out of a possible eleven, for a response rate of 82%. The results are presented below.

# Results: Board Role and Responsibility

Satisfaction with the board chair was also reported.

It is recommended the Medical Officer of Health review these results and share them with the Board of Health. As well, it is recommended that these results be shared with staff.
