Diarrhea & vomiting, influenza, measles, meningitis, mumps, rubella, and whooping cough (pertussis) must all be reported immediately by telephone to the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit at 613-345-5685 or 1-800-660-5853.

NOT REPORTABLE:

Ear infection, fifth disease, hand, foot & mouth disease, impetigo, mononucleosis, pink eye, and strep throat/scarlet fever.
