# **Exemption Process for Immunization Record Submission for Schools**

All children (kindergarten to Grade 12) entering school in Ontario must be immunized against Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Polio, Meningococcal Disease, Varicella (chicken pox), Measles, Mumps and Rubella according to the <a href="mailto:lmmunization of School Pupils Act">lmmunization of School Pupils Act</a>, 1990 and Regulation 645.

The Act allows for exemptions in 2 ways.

### **Medical Exemption Process**

- A child may be exempted from required immunizations based on an assessment by their physician or nurse practitioner.
- Medical exemptions may be permanent or temporary.
- Exemptions may be granted based on contraindications (allergies to vaccine components), laboratory confirmation of immunity or diagnosis of prior disease
- The original, completed <u>Statement of Medical Exemption Form Immunization of School Pupils Act</u> with a physician's or nurse practitioner's signature must be submitted to the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit.

## **Conscience or Religious Belief Exemption Process**

To qualify for a Conscience or religious belief exemption, parents/caregivers must:

- Complete an immunization education session provided by the Health Unit as per <u>Immunization of School Pupils Act, 1990</u>
  AND
- Complete and sign the <u>Statement of Conscience or Religious Belief</u> form and then have it signed by a commissioner for taking affidavits. (examples include a Notary Public, a Lawyer or a Paralegal)
- The original signed document must be submitted to the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit.
