






## LGL COVID-19 Status

- Low level of new infections less than 10/100,000 population – Green Prevent Zone
- Mostly household contact, clusters outside households, workplace, some travel.
- Occasional single case in LTC/RH

## COVID Variants of Concern (VOC)



- COVID-19 virus mutates readily with replication
- A VOC is one that may have impact on transmission, virulence and vaccine efficacy.
- B.1.1.7 (UK), 501Y.V2 (SA), P.1 (Brazil)
- UK penetrates cell easily easily spread, early symptoms, possible increased death risk
- VOC screening for all COVID-19 positive specimens
- Public Health Ontario Lab increase # detected each week

## Community Prevention of VOC Spread: Strict Public Health Measures

#### **Be COVID-smart:**





Mask/face covering on when in enclosed public spaces and when physical distancing is a challenge outdoors.



Avoid touching your face.



Remain 2 metres/6 feet apart from people you do not live with and people not in your <u>social circle</u>.



Twenty (20) seconds for regular <u>hand hygiene</u>. Cover your coughs and sneezes.



Workplaces, business and services follow provincial requirements in Green Prevent Zone – Reg. 364/20



- In LGL, Pfizer and Moderna (mRNA) vaccines
- Adults, 2 doses 21 and 28 days apart
- 95% effective
- Mild usual vaccine side effects

### Vaccine Phase 1: Provincial Priorities

#### Stage 1

Long-Term Care Homes/High Risk Retirement Homes
 Residents (completed), Staff, and Designated Essential Care Givers (now)

#### Stage 2:

- Hospital ALC individuals with admission to congregate care
- Hospital Emerg & COVID medical units
- Medical First Responders, Assessment Centre staff, vaccine teams, home and community care workers.

### Stage 3:

- Adults (80+)
- Other front line health care workers
- Residents and staff of seniors congregate living facilities
- Adult recipients of chronic home care



### Vaccine Phase 2: Provincial Priorities

#### Stage 4:

Essential Workers (e.g. first responders, teachers)

#### Stage 5:

 Medical high risk population and beginning of age cohorting (ages 70+ to start)

#### Stage 6:

 All others in Leeds, Grenville and Lanark that are 16 + and would like the vaccine

## LGL Vaccine Access

- Hospital Clinics: health care workers
- Mobile Clinics: LTC, RH, congregate settings
- Fixed Sites: Brockville, Kemptville, Smiths Falls,
   Almonte
- Pop-Up Sites: LGL local municipalities
- Outreach Teams: home, other
- Pharmacies: fridge stored vaccine
- Primary Care Offices: fridge stored vaccine

## LGL- Points of Access




**Fixed Site Location**
