


Introduction/Methodology

- Indigenous community engagement specifically mentioned in the OPHS in terms of health equity.
- This is a sizeable population in LGL.
- Demographic and health data obtained from 2016 Census of Canada and combined cycles of the Canadian Community Health Survey 2010-2014 (Statistics Canada).
- Term 'indigenous' refers to whether a person identified as being First Nations (North American Indian), Métis or Inuk (Inuit) in the Census or CCHS.


Counts of indigenous population by municipality in LGLDHU.

Total indigenous population percentage by geography








 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by age distribution.


Population comparison by age group in LGL



Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by sense of community belonging.




 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by healthy eating status.




 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by lack of life stress.

Self-perceived life stress in LGL (a bit to none)




 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by lack of self-perceived work stress.

Self-perceived work stress in LGL (a bit to none)




 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by daily leisure time physical activity levels.

 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by smoking status.



 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by self-perceived health.


Self-perceived health in LGL (good to excellent)

 Comparison of overall population in LGLDHU and that of the indigenous population by lack of a diabetes diagnoses.


Diabetes in LGL (none)

Mood disorder diagnosis	↑ For indigenous population
