Subject: Public Health Update - Paxlovid

The Ministry of Health has expanded the Paxlovid COVID-19 antiviral medication program.

COVID-19 antiviral treatment | COVID-19 (coronavirus) in Ontario

New groups are also now eligible for PCR testing at Assessment/Testing Centres so that more people, who could have serious infection, are aware they have COVID-19, and can be considered by a physician for Paxlovid therapy.

- Anyone 70+
- Anyone 18+ who is immune-compromised
- Anyone 60+ who has NOT had 3 doses of vaccine
- Anyone 18+ who has NOT had 3 doses of vaccine AND has at least one risk factor (see link for details)

The public can use this link to see if they are eligible: https://covid-19.ontario.ca/covid-treatment-screener

People who fit the eligibility criteria above are encouraged to see their health care provider now so they can be assessed for eligibility for Paxlovid, including assessing possible drug interactions, and then be given a prescription for Paxlovid should they develop COVID-19 symptoms and receive a positive test – either PCR or RAT.

Paxlovid will now be available in community pharmacies with a prescription from community or hospital-based physicians. The listing of pharmacies will be on the provincial Website on Wednesday, April 13th at 8:00 a.m. The plan is to add more pharmacies over time.
