

DO YOU NEED YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORDS FOR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY?

- * Health care providers do not automatically send immunization information to the Health Unit.
- ★ If you would like to obtain a copy of what the Health Unit has on record for your immunizations, please use the ICON web portal

ICON web portal: You will need your health card to log in. You are able to see what we already have on file and upload a picture of any additional vaccination records. We review all submissions of records and once they are validated, we will update the immunization record. We will notify you by email once this is finished so you can have an up to date, complete record. Please allow a week or two for this to happen after you upload.



PLEASE submit original records from your care provider, we are unable to accept copies from a tracking app.
